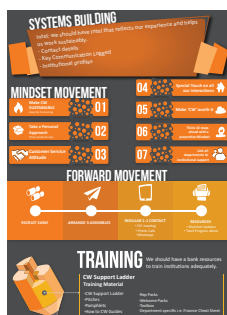
Building the Teams

Resource Distribution

Working together, year-on-year means Charity Week has been able to re-use and share resources. With the help of our participating institutions, we were able to significantly reduce our bucket orders this year. More and more print material is designed to be “future-proof” as we strive to use our funds as effectively as possible.

Hand-in-hand with training, Charity Week provides all the physical resources to deliver the campaign. The logistics of providing a variety of resources to diversely sized institutions has always posed a challenge to efficiency.

Institutions were categorised according to size. Packages of T-shirts, print materials and buckets were tailor-made for each category, hence saving time and potential waste.

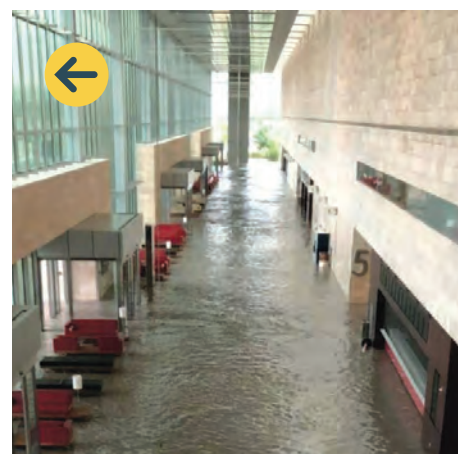

Later when they went to thank the owner, the store had raised even more money for the cause!

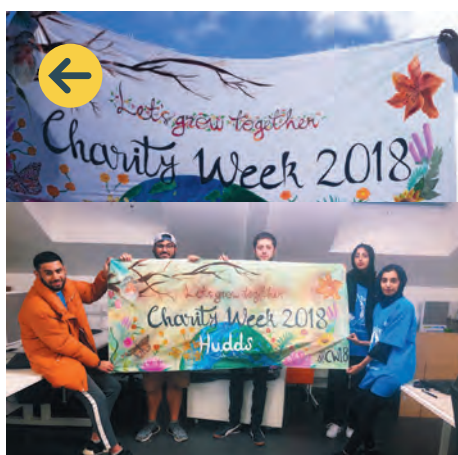


We've Grown Together

Consolidating our Presence

The number of Charity Week accounts on Twitter and Facebook was significantly reduced in order to consolidate followers and achieve a more streamlined presence on the platform. Regional Charity Week groups were subsumed into National accounts and this positively benefitted the visibility of the project across social media.

International Branding

This year we sought to make Charity Week more identifiable internationally by enforcing tighter branding guidelines to our marketing teams. The use of brand colours, fonts, social media templates and diligent attention to logo presentation meant that this year, Charity Week graphics were instantly recognisable.

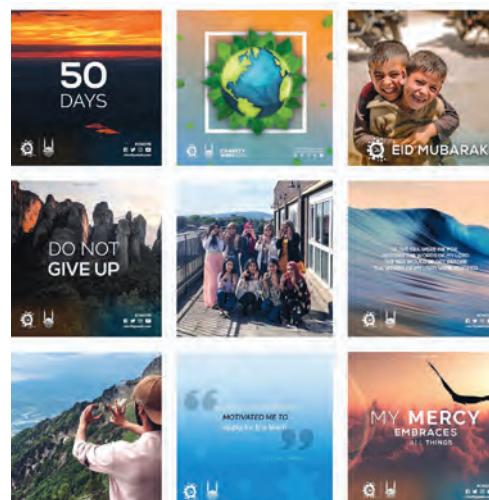

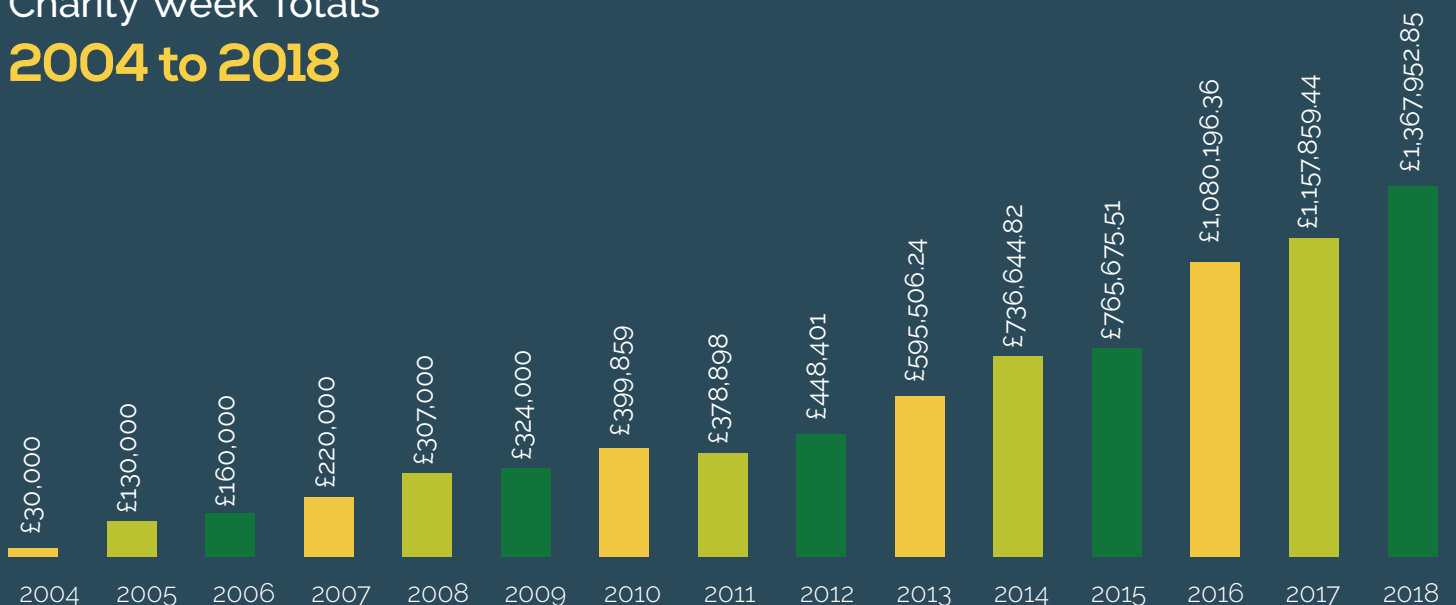

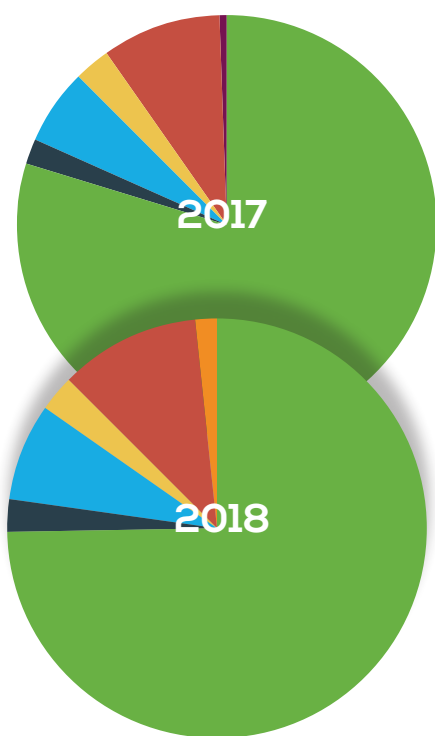

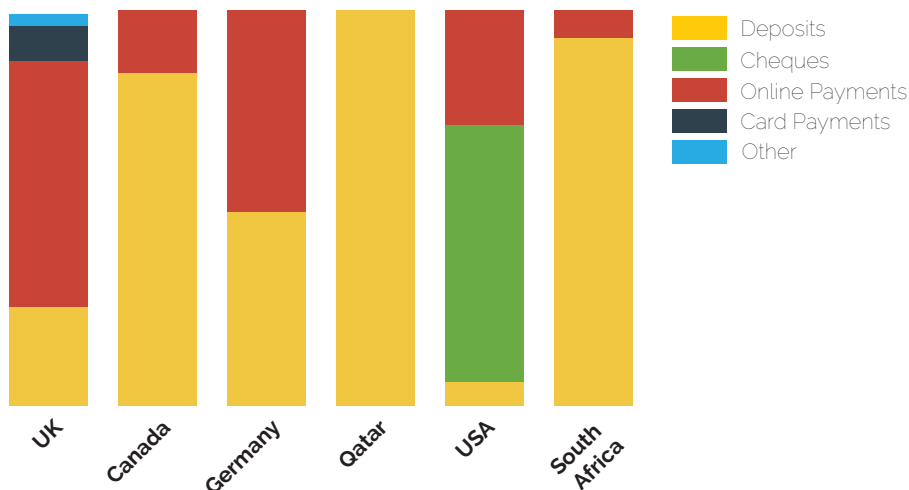
The portion of the CW total raised by the US in 2018

Decrease in the UK's portion of the CW total between 2017 & 2018

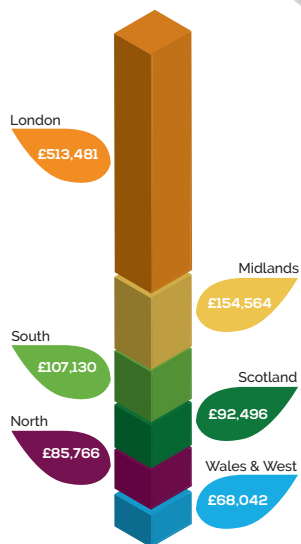
Donations Structure



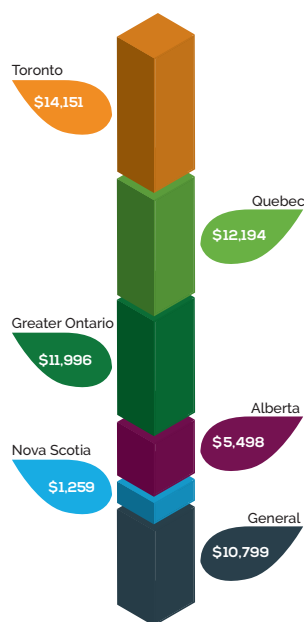

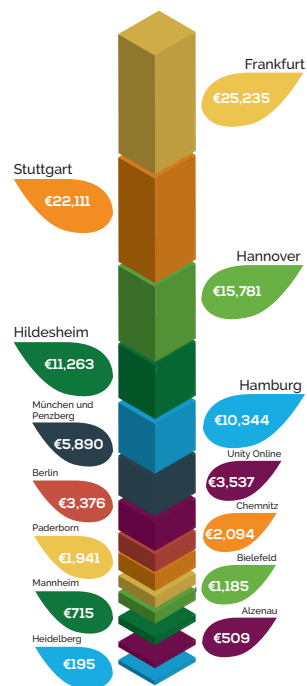

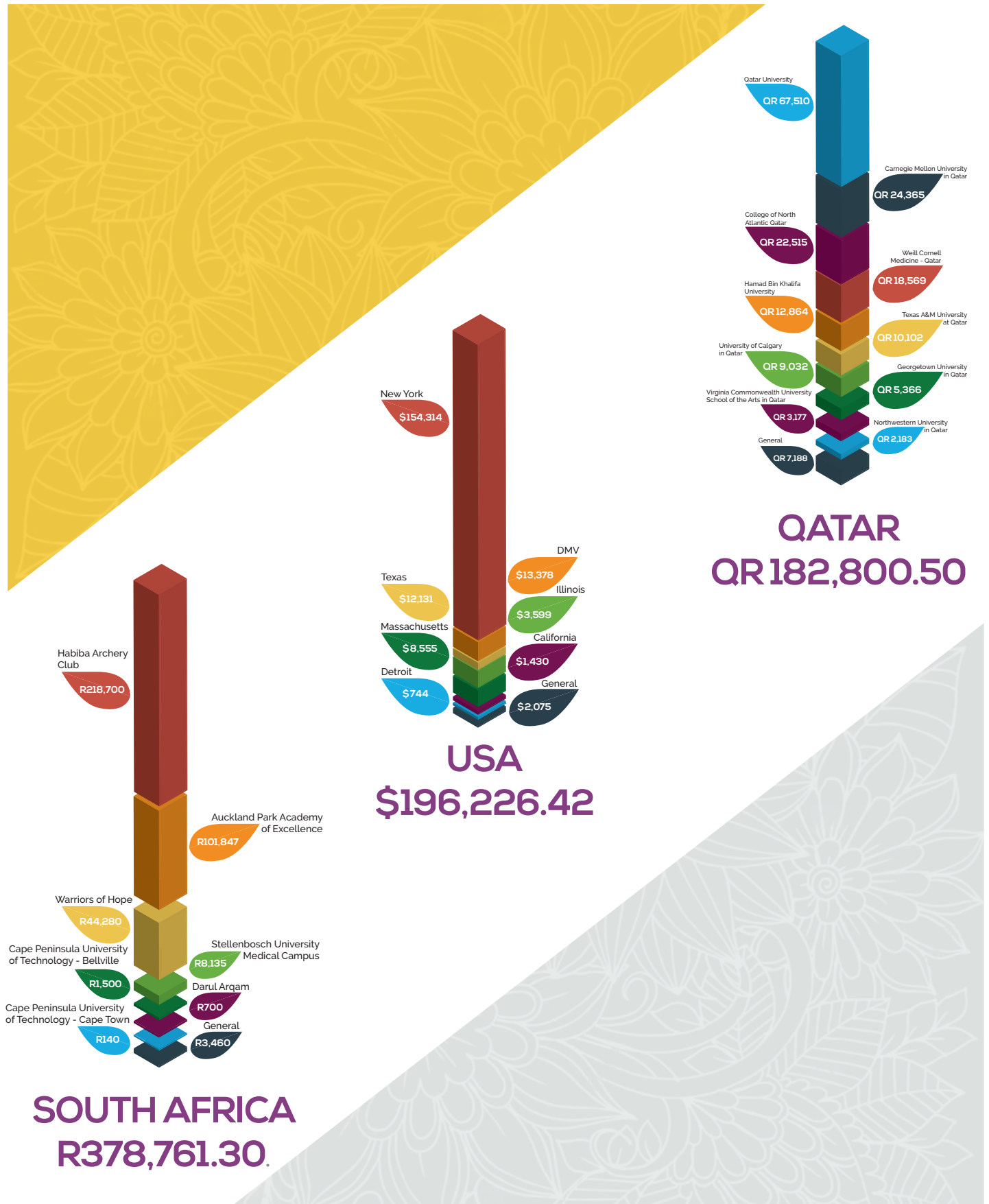

Annual Dinners

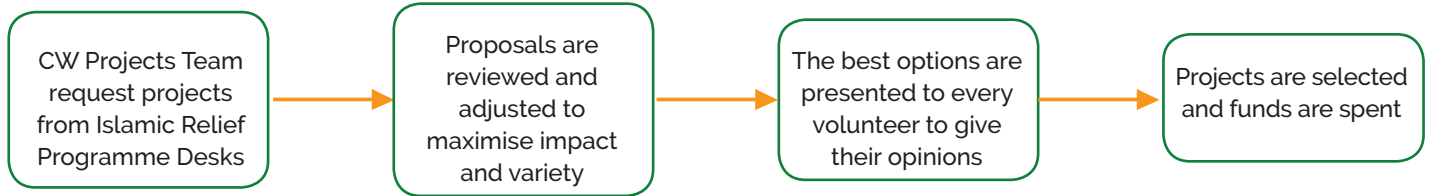

Where the Money Goes



By planning together, working together and raising together, the end result of Charity Week is that we have the ability to spend the money we raised together on so many more projects that we could have ever done separately.

This year we have funded a variety of projects and were able to meet demands from the immediate disasters in Indonesia and Syria as well as more long-term projects.

Locations of Charity Week 2019 Projects



From the money raised, an additional £18,800 was utilised to top-up a project that Charity Week started funding last year in Gaza. We were able to renew funding for screening, fitting hearing aids and providing surgery where necessary to infants and pre-school aged children.



CERCLE DE KATI, MALI

Where Climate Change and Poverty Meet



This project addresses the education, health and livelihood needs of children across five villages - approximately 3,000 beneficiaries



A **Maternity Centre** has been funded to ensure that children have the **best possible healthcare** from the day they are born.

It is equipped with **medicines**, an **ambulance** and **midwives**, trained to help with complicated births.

THREE PRIMARY SCHOOLS HAVE BEEN EQUIPPED WITH:

- Solar panels for clean energy
- A clean water supply for drinking and toileting
- Child protection clubs to prevent child abuse
- Safe spaces to help with mental well-being
- Trees, planted to help the environment

Street Children in Extreme Poverty



Rawalpindi's streets are home to many children who are completely alone due to crises and disasters which have displaced them from the Northern territories.

Awareness sessions are being carried out with children on the importance of **hygiene** and **balanced diets**

Vocational training is available now for older children to **nurture skills** as well as **connecting** them with potential employers. Disabled children are assessed in order to address their **specific needs**. The underlying aim is to build orphans' and children's **self confidence** and **dignity**

Psychosocial support sessions are being provided for children to overcome **trauma** from living on the streets

This project addresses **multiple needs** and is helping 200 children through **food insecurity**, providing **vital education** as well as support through **psychological trauma**.
