### Resource Distribution

Working together, year-on-year means Charity Week has been able to re-use and share resources. With the help of our participating institutions, we were able to significantly reduce our bucket orders this year. More and more print material is designed to be "future-proof" as we strive to use our funds as effectively as possible.

Hand-in-hand with training, Charity Week provides all the physical resources to deliver the campaign. The logistics of providing a variety of resources to diversely sized institutions has always posed a challenge to efficiency.

Institutions were categorised according to size. Packages of T-shirts, print materials and buckets were tailor-made for each category, hence saving time and potential waste.



In the run up to Charity Week, German Charity Weekers challenged Muslims in Ramadan to abstain from using disposable plastic water bottles - and instead take a re-usable flask to tarawih prayers instead.

Sponsored treks are a huge part of Charity Week in the UK and this year was no different. Leaving behind the heaving cities to experience the wild beauty of Mount Snowdon, hundreds of volunteers braved the cold to raise money.





#### Pencils with Seeds York MSA, Canada

A creative environmental initiative by York MSA included selling pencils that contain seeds. After using the pencil, rather than throwing them in the garbage, they can be planted to grow trees.







#### Consolidating our Presence

The number of Charity Week accounts on Twitter and Facebook was significantly reduced in order to consolidate followers and achieve a more streamlined presence on the platform. Regional Charity Week groups were subsumed into National accounts and this positively benefitted the visibility of the project across social media.

#### International Branding

This year we sought to make Charity Week more identifiable internationally by enforcing tigher branding guidelines to our marketing teams. The use of brand colours, fonts, social media templates and diligent attention to logo presentation meant that this year, Charity Week graphics were instantly recognisable.







#### **Donations Structure**





### **Annual Dinners**



## Where the Money Goes



By planning together, working together and raising together, the end result of Charity Week is that we have the ability to spend the money we raised together on so many more projects that we could have ever done separately.

This year we have funded a variety of projects and were able to meet demands from the immediate disasters in Indonesia and Syria as well as more long-term projects.

From the money raised, an additional £18,800 was utilised to top-up a project that Charity Week started funding last year in Gaza. We were able to renew funding for screening, fitting hearing aids and providing surgery where necessary to infants and pre-school aged children.

Facilities include all furniture, conference rooms and even IT equipment such as laptops and printers. In addition, two playgrounds and a sports club ensure that they can enjoy the playtime they have missed up until now.

## Conclusion

When we first unveiled the theme of the environment, there were many who asked, "what has the environment got to do with charity?" It shows how disconnected we are from the reality that those who suffer the most from climate change are the underprivileged of this world. It shows we have become used to living unsustainable lifestyles, running unsustainable projects and pushing unsustainable solutions.

The environment was never just a theme for us. It is our Islamic duty as caretakers of this earth. Only when we combine saving the world with saving the people in it will we be able to grow together.

Anas ibn Malik reported: The Messenger of Allah, peace and blessings be upon him, said, "If the Resurrection were established upon one of you while he has in his hand a sapling, then let him plant it."
